Current Activities (2012 - 2015)

- For the [Mediathek](#) of the Institute I have been editing the conference video and audio of the past 5 years. We now have over 240 talks, interviews, etc. recorded and published on this website. The website is divided into a public part (which will be used by our Public Relation in 2015) and a closed area. The closed area can be accessed on demand (user/password) or in our own network.
- For the Research group of Sabine Arnaud I developed a group working environment (based on Magnolia) with which documents, images, texts can be sorted, resorted or edited in a web-based server environment (JAVA, Magnolia, JackRabbit, Lucene, Solr). [Web-Site](#)
- I organized and held teachings in Publishing on bases of Photoshop, InDesign, OCR.
- With the help of workflows, I designed for the Mediathek, some groups in the institute are now able to publish out of the conference context (Audio, Transcriptions, Access from over the world, Video) in collaborative way.
- The conference technique of our institute will be renewed completely in 2017. Therefore there will be new audio equipment, video live broadcasting, audio and video recording in HD quality, video-conference equipment. I am leading this works technically for our institute since 2013.
- With Dagmar Schäfer the project: "Multi media and the History of Science / Sound of Silk film project. The project examines ways of creating scientific articles - editorially and technically - through multi-media. Articles are being prepared in the history of science, history of technology and cultural conditions of science.
